


Message from Chairperson

Dear all students, parents, teachers & partners all over the world

Welcome to join Hong Kong International Science Olympiad Heat Round 2022 - 2023. For the 4th year, there are 10 teams and nearly 3000 candidates to join the heat round. This is a wonderful result for all of us to be interested in HKISO Final which should be held at National University of Singapore, NUS for the fourth year too.

Hong Kong International Science Olympiad, HKISO is an international science competition that aims to stimulate curiosity and an attitude of discovery, promote an understanding of the progress that has been taking place in the field of science for hundreds of years, encourage the integration of ideas and disciplines, encourage truth-seeking, let students study important scientists who ask good questions, in order to get better answers, one of the free participation projects in the HKISO Preliminary Competition is called Science Experiment, and participants can shoot a short film with a specified topic in 5 minutes. Share your scientific knowledge with contestants from around the world.

HKISO consists of 4 main categories: Physics, Biology, Chemistry and Integrative Sciences, which closely follows the Hong Kong school science syllabus and tests the level of content students have learned. This allows participants to be well prepared in different categories to understand their strengths and weaknesses in terms of preparation. The Finals will be co-organised with the National University of Singapore (NUS), the number one university of Singapore, and students who have won the Bronze Medal or above in the preliminary round will be invited to Singapore to study STEM education in Singapore and have a genuine academic exchange with participants from different regions.
